## CASE STUDY: CASPER, WYOMING














## CASE STUDY: CITY OF BOWLING GREEN, OHIO City of Bowling Green, OH City ED office gained site control of 9 parcels both through ownership and development agreements – 247 acres Completed housing market analysis Issued RFP for Midwest developers Offering residential housing tax abatement assistance Negotiating with developer and builder to begin new Construction Abbott Laboratories, Inc. announced \$500 million investment and 450 new jobs in December 2022
