

Megan Flores is the Controller for the City of Hammond, Indiana. As Controller, Megan serves as the Chief Financial Officer for the City and is responsible for preparing annual budgets, investing City funds, compiling accounting data to prepare the annual financial reports, administering payroll and payment of claims, and managing the City's insurance and retirement plans. She also serves as Assistant Treasurer on the Hammond Local Public Improvement Bond Bank, Commissioner for the City of Hammond Capital Improvement Board, and member of the Hammond Development Corporation Business Loan Committee.



Megan began working for the City of Hammond as an intern in the Mayor's Office in 2010 and later became Assistant to the Chief of Staff. In 2012, she was promoted to Facility Operations Manager within the city's Park Department where she managed the day-to-day operations of the Jean Shepherd Community Center and Dowling Park Athletics Complex. Megan accepted the position of Staff Accountant within the Controller's office in 2017. Previous Controller Heather Garay then appointed her to the role of Budget and Reporting Administrator until being appointed to the position of City Controller by Mayor Thomas. M. McDermott Jr. in January 2020.

As a lifelong resident of Hammond, Indiana, Megan has been involved in various community and youth organizations as a volunteer coach for Hammond Youth Hoops, Hessville Little League, and Hessville Vipers.

Megan earned her Bachelor of Science in Accountancy from Indiana Wesleyan University in 2018 and later went on to obtain her Master of Science in Accountancy in 2019.
